

Eldad Corbett

Eldad Corbett was born on 3 March 1752 in Mendon, Worcester, Massachusetts to Deacon Daniel Corbett, Jr, and Mary Holbrook, he was one of 12 children. Eldad married twice -- Hanna Sterns (20 July 1775) then Lydia Barre. He Died on 1 November 1831 in Bridgewater, Oneida, New York and is buried in the Fairview Cemetery there.

Eldad served in the Massachusetts under Captain Oliver Avery. Capt. Oliver Avery's Company of Minutemen marched on the Lexington Alarm, the first battle of the Revolutionary War, and performed seventeen days' service. Eldad also served under Captains Hugh Maxwell (one of the Massachusetts Minutemen) and Seth Howard, Colonels William Prescott and David Wells.
