

John Swartley

Born in Germany in 1754, John Swartley relocated to Pennsylvania. He died in 1817 in Franconia Township, probably in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. John Swartley paid the Effective Supply Tax during the Revolutionary war. He is on record as having paid the Effective Supply Tax which supported the war effort. He was a Mennonite and the son-in-law of a Mennonite minister. His wife was Magdalena Rosenberger, the daughter of a Mennonite minister, and they had four children together.
