

Henry Ott

Henry Ott was born January 5, 1743 in Freckenfeld, Germany to Hans Michael and Maria Barbara Catherine Steinbach. He was one of 12 children. He lived in Keller's Church, Bedminster Township, Bucks County, PA with his wife Maria Barbara Steinbach where they raised 10 children. He died on April 20, 1805 in Bedminster at the age of 62 and was buried in the Tohickon Cemetery on Old Bethlehem Road, Perkasie, PA.

Henry swore his *Oath of Allegiance* on June 8, 1778 to Captain William McHenry, 5th Company, Bedminster Township Bucks County, PA. He served as a Private in the Bucks County Militia, 2nd Battalion 1778 led by Col. Arthur Erwin with four of his brothers: Jacob, Benjamin, John and Peter Ott.
