

Adam Fleck

(Johan) Adam Fleck Was born in Sweden in 1739 with the name Johann Adam Fleck. All his brothers also had the first name "Johann" so he was known as "Adam". He came to Pennsylvania with his father and family. At sixteen, he was 'promoted' to the Holy Communion at his church. From their records: "On the 20th of April, 1755, the following young persons were confirmed in the Evangelical doctrine at New Hanover, and were advanced to the Holy Communion: (including) Johan Adam Fleck, Conrad Fleck's son, 16 years. Can read tolerably well . . ." He married Maria Margaret Gable Week/Wiggin and they had at least five children. He served as a Private in the Philadelphia County Militia under Captain John Shelmire. He died on April 27, 1820 in Center Square, Montgomery County, PA, and is buried in the St. John's Lutheran Church Cemetery in Center Square.
