

Jonathan Janes

Jonathan Janes was born on August 1, 1726, at Northampton, Hampshire County, Massachusetts. He married twice, first to Esther Clark with whom he had no children, and then to Hannah Parsons about 1763. They had eight children: Esther, Ebenezer, Lois, Rebecca, Lt. Jonathon, Parsons (1st who died as a child), Obadiah, Parsons (2nd).

Jonathan Janes served as a private in Captain Samuel Merriman's company, Colonel Phineas Wright's 6th Hampshire County Regiment. He enlisted on September 22, 1777 and was discharged on October 18, 1777, serving 1 month and 3 days in the Northern department, including 7 days (140 miles) travel home.

He died April 24, 1825, at Easthampton, Hampshire County, Massachusetts
