

Moses Leonard

Born November 25, 1761 in Watertown, Middlesex County, Massachusetts, Moses Leonard was married to Sarah 'Sally' Pratt. They had at least eight children: Moses, Abigail, Lucy, Joel, Nathan, Jerusha, Ira, and Louisa, There are variations of the spelling of his last name from Leonard to Lanard and Learned.

He died on June 21, 1845 in Halifax, Windham County, Vermont, and is buried in Halifax Center Cemetery, Halifax, Windham County, Vermont.

Moses Leonard served under Captains Benjamin Whitney and Sumners, and Colonel Grayton in the Petersham Company. Petersham, Massachusetts, was the site of the second battle of Shays' Rebellion on February 4, 1787, though there is no record of Moses Leonard having been there at that time.
